Year 1	Drawing – Crazy Hats (sketch designs of hats then bring in own hat to turn into their own designs)	Painting - Piet Mondrian (including naming primary colour)	Sculpture – Andy Goldsworthy (Natural sculptures – focus on shape, form, space and texture, include mini-project on printing with natural objects)	
Year 2	Drawing – Royal Portraits (how to draw a face, focus on line and proportion)	Painting – Henri Matisse (including naming and making secondary colour)	Sculpture – Animal Sculptures (Clay sculptures of animals focusing on texture – e.g. tortoise shell/skin)
